Dear Friends,

By now, most of you be well aware of our upcoming centenary celebration due to be launched in September 2017. It will be a most exciting celebration which will involve and be meaningful for anyone who is or has been involved with De La Salle College, since its inception.

It was in September 1917 that the school was founded by Brother Edward and it is wonderful to realise that, from those humble beginnings, the College has developed and grown into the thriving community that it is today.

The preparations for this memorable milestone have already begun, with the official launch date for the commemorative events being 22 September 2017. On that day, celebrations will begin with a Special Mass at St Thomas Catholic Church and the day will end with a Centenary Ball.

We are delighted to announce that the Centenary Ball will take place in Trinity at the RJAHS from 7pm that evening and our team of volunteers are busily working behind the scenes, collaborating with caterers, AV companies and musical entertainers to name but a few, to ensure this event is a truly fabulous occasion. Our choice of venue means we have capacity to accommodate a higher volume of guests than at any hotel venue, yet early indicators still point towards demand for tables exceeding supply!

With this in mind, we're calling on you for your support as early as possible to avoid disappointment. Now is the time to get organised by securing your table of ten this term so you don't miss out. A few simple steps are outlined below to help ease the process:

1. Nominate and provide the name of an efficient person to coordinate your table(s).
2. Indicate how many tables of ten you wish to book by emailing [l.sale@dls-jersey.co.uk](mailto:l.sale@dls-jersey.co.uk). A table of ten costs a total of £850, to include fizz upon arrival, a three course meal and half a bottle of wine per person. A cash bar will be available throughout the evening too. Once Leesa confirms your request with your coordinator, full payment will be required preferably by bank transfer (this will help to ease the administrative issues) to secure the booking by no later than 30<sup>th</sup> April 2017.
3. If you can't make up one table, but still want to attend, please indicate how many tickets you require at £85pp, providing names of guests, and we'll endeavour to make up some tables on your behalf. Once Leesa confirms your request, payment will be required preferably by bank transfer to secure the booking by no later than 30<sup>th</sup> April 2017.
4. Although menus are still being firmed up, an early indication of any specific dietary requirements on table bookings would be most appreciated.
5. Closer to the event, we'll require guest names for each table in order to coordinate table plans for the evening. Again this will be organised via Leesa Sale and your table coordinator in due course.

So, for now, please get your heads together to coordinate your table, get in touch with Leesa Sale to secure it and make sure the evening of Friday, 22 September is firmly in your diaries.

It promises to be a night to remember!
