### **Jersey Sings Volunteers required**

'Music in Action' is currently looking for volunteers aged between 16 to 25 to become Jersey Sings Ambassadors and be part of the team who will deliver the event. Jersey Sings takes place on the 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> June at Fort Regent and will involve around 1,600 pupils.

Each Ambassador will be assigned to a school and ensure they are directed to their allocated reserved area and have all that they require pre and post the shows.

To ensure the volunteers get value from the programme and to assist in future employability we have arranged for them to undertake World Host Customer Service and Ambassador training. The training will be facilitated by Rebecca Cook from Butterfly Training and will be held at the Baclays Eagle Lab at Jersey Library on Wednesday 31st May from 09.30 – 13.30. All Ambassadors will receive a certificate and the qualification is valid for 24 months – a great addition to their cv. For reference it was the Butterfly Training that was provided to the Island Games marshals.

They would need to be available on both or either of the 13th and 14th June and it would be a full day from 10am to 9pm as it covers both rehearsals and performance.

**Results Day:** This year's A-level Results Day is on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> August. College will be open from 10 am, but UCAS students should note that they can log-on to this UCAS server at 8am to find out if they have secured their First or Insurance Choice

**UCAS Direct Contact Service:** If your son a UCAS applicant, it would be a very sensible idea for him to sign up to their Direct Contact Service: <https://www.ucas.com/ucas/undergraduate/apply-and-track/results/no-offers-use-clearing/direct-contact-service>. It serves two purposes, but at this stage of year, it is beneficial to help any students who find themselves on results day having not secured their First or Insurance place. In very brief, it gives permission for other universities to look at your son's profile (i.e. UCAS application, including Personal Statement and Reference), and they can contact him directly to offer you a place at their university.
