Top tips during the Exam

- Read through the paper first.
- Organise the order in which you will answer the questions.
- Generally, there will be approximately 1 mark per minute.
- For any exam where you are required to write extended answers: make your **Point**, provide some **Evidence** to support your point, **Explain** your reasons for making the point, **Link** to the next thing you are going to write about.
- Pay attention at all times to **Spelling Punctuation and Grammar**. Every sentence starts with a CAPITAL letter and ends with a full stop.
- If you finish within the time allocated; read through the paper checking for spelling and punctuation. Does each sentence make sense?
