### French Day Trip to St. Malo.

#### **Meet Elizabeth Terminal (With Passport) - 8.00am.**

The boys will depart and arrive from the Elizabeth Terminal and travel to St. Malo on a Condor Ferry. Staff will accompany small groups of boys around the old town as they complete various tasks and challenges set by our French Department. This activity represents the bulk of the cost as it includes ferry transit as well as all of the safety precautions and insurance arrangements. Boys should arrive at the **Elizabeth Ferry Terminal at 7.45am for a 8.55am sailing**, and they should be collected from the terminal which is scheduled to arrive in Jersey at 6.00pm (Monday) 5.30pm (Wednesday). Boys will need 15 Euro for Lunch, but boys should also bring snacks and a drink and have a small amount of extra cash so as to buy gifts etc.

### History Field Trip to Mont Orgueil Castle.

#### **Meet outside Mr Perree's Room – 8.45am.**

Students will travel on a coach to and from the castle and spend the day engaged in history based activities in and around the castle as well as some creative work on the beach. They should come to school in sensible casual clothes with suitable protection from the weather on the day. They will need a packed lunch, plenty to drink, their pencil cases as well as buckets and spades for the beach. Boys should come to and from school in the usual manner.

### Art Visit to Durrell.

#### **Meet outside Mr Pallot's Room – 8.45am.**

Students will travel on a coach to and from the Park. They will take part in a number of activities run by our Art Department at Durrell. They should come to school in sensible casual clothes with suitable protection from the weather on the day. They will need a packed lunch, plenty to drink and their pencil cases. Boys should come to and from school in the usual manner.

### Geography Field Visit to St. Aubin.

#### **Meet outside Mrs Hunt's Room – 8.45am.**

Students will travel on a coach to and from St. Aubin's village. They will collect Geographical Survey data from around the St. Aubin's & St Brelade area which they will use for future work at school. They should come to school in sensible casual clothes with suitable protection from the weather on the day. They will need a packed lunch, plenty to drink and their pencil cases. Boys should come to and from school in the usual manner.

Physical Education

**Meet outside Games Hall – 8.45am.**

Students will be involved in a range of Challenge and Adventure activities for the day. Boys will spend the day at school using the full range of facilities. They should come to school in their usual games kit and track suits. They should have suitable protection from the weather on the day as some of it will be outside. Normal lunch arrangements will still apply and boys should expect to come to and from school in the usual manner.
